

Weds, Dec. 4 beginning at noon - Advent Lunch & Learn 1



Triple L Homeless Project

The Triple L Homeless Project began on August 28th; touching the lives of the least, the last, and the lost in the Blue Ridge community. Our mission: to bring nourshing & nurturing meals to lay a foundation of trust, and to bridge the gap of hopelessness, lonesomeness, and brokenness by being the conduit to resources that can help assist where needed. To finish out the year, the Triple L Homeless Project still needs volunteers for the following event:

Wednesday, December 25th (Christmas Day) —Homeless dinner at Covet Hair Salon (4060 E. First Street, Blue Ridge). 1 or 2 people needed to shop, cook, and drop off food (enough to serve 12 people) at 1:30 p.m. Also needed: 1 person to meet at the church at 12:30 to work on site from 2-4 p.m. A sign—up sheet is available in the Narthex for anyone able to help.

Family Connections Food Drive

The Faith Mission Team was recently informed about food shortages that have occurred in our community.
