Faith Presbyterian Church - Suggestion Form: Nomination of Elders Three Elders for the Class of 2028 (three-year term)

The Nominating Committee asks the members of Faith Presbyterian to prayerfully consider those members whom God might be calling to serve, due to their gifts for leadership and service, for the ordained ministry of Ruling Elder and to suggest the names to the Church Nominating Committee. Three Ruling Elders will be elected by the Congregation to begin their term of service in January 2028 for a three-year term.

Please consider the list of Criteria for Elders at Faith Presbyterian Church and make your suggestions on the reverse side of this form. Please do not ask a person's permission prior to offering their name as a suggestion.

Criteria to consider in suggesting a member(s) to serve as an Elder.

Member of Faith Presbyterian Church for at least one year.

Commitment to Christ, the church, and its mission.

Regular attendance at public worship.

Active participation in the life of the church beyond attendance at worship services.

Demonstrates leadership in the life of the church.

Ability to maintain confidentiality.

Ability and availability to complete tasks and fulfill responsibilities with a positive attitude.

Willingness to delegate responsibilities.

Willingness to listen to other viewpoints and ability to be a peacemaker of the church.

Ability to initiate and accept change.

Previous or current serving Elders are eligible to be nominated. Elders cannot serve more than two consecutive 3-year terms. (*Book of Order*, G-2.0404) "...no ruling elder ... shall be eligible to serve more than six consecutive years, and a ruling elder who has served six consecutive years shall be ineligible for election to the same board for at least one year."

Spouses or immediate family members cannot serve as Elders at the same time.

Elders: (*Book of Order*, G-2.0301) "... congregations should elect persons of wisdom and maturity of faith, having demonstrated skills in leadership and being compassionate in spirit. Ruling elders are ... chosen by the congregation to discern and measure its fidelity to the Word of God, and to strengthen and nurture its faith and life. Ruling elders, together with teaching elders, exercise leadership, government, spiritual discernment, and discipline and have responsibilities for the life of a congregation as well as the whole church, including ecumenical relationships."

(Book of Order: G-2014A) "Their manner of life should be a demonstration of the Christian gospel in the church and in the world.

In the Faith congregation, Elders serve as the co-chairs or chair of the five Session Planning Teams: Administration Planning Team, Congregational Care Planning Team, Mission Planning Team, Outreach Planning Team, and Spiritual Development Planning Team.
